2017 AB 1491 Caballero:

Article 4. Sales of Dogs and Cats: Advertising

122316. It is unlawful to do any of the following when advertising the sale of a dog or cat to the public in this state: (a) Offer pictures or otherwise make representations regarding a dog or cat that do not depict the actual dog or cat available for purchase by the public.

(b) Make or disseminate any statement about the dog or cat being advertised for sale that is known, or by the exercise of reasonable care should be known, to be false or misleading.

(c) Make or disseminate any statement about the dog or cat being advertised for sale with the intent not to sell to the public the actual dog or cat so advertised.

122317. It is unlawful to fail to withdraw in writing an advertisement for the sale of a dog or cat within 48 hours after selling the dog or cat or withdrawing the dog or cat from sale.

122318. (a) A person who violates this article is subject to a civil penalty of not less than five hundred dollars (\$500) and not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000) for each violation.

(b) The Attorney General, or the city attorney of the city or the district attorney or county counsel of the county in which a violation of this article occurs, may bring a civil action in a court of competent jurisdiction to assess and recover the civil penalty described in subdivision (a). The civil penalty, when collected, shall be payable, as appropriate, to the general fund of whichever governmental entity brought the action to assess the civil penalty.
