## Local Rabies Control Activities 2014 Annual Report

Every year since 1987, the Director of the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has declared all 58 counties in California as endemic for rabies, requiring each county to maintain a rabies control program per the California Health & Safety Code (§121690(e)). In 2014, approximately 300 city and county agencies in California conducted mandated rabies control activities, including issuing licenses to domestic dogs, providing “actual cost” public rabies vaccination clinics, and enforcing quarantine of animals following a reported bite incident. This report summarizes local rabies control activity data reported to CDPH for the year 2014.
