



LICENSE FEES

ALTERED DOGS

Regular license: **\$26** for one year
\$46 for two years (rabies vaccination must be valid for license term)
\$66 for three years (rabies vaccination must be valid for license term)

Senior license: **\$26** – one time fee (one senior license per household; 65 years of age or older, no fee to renew for the lifetime of the dog.)

FERTILE DOGS (one year license only)

Regular license: **\$65** for one year

Senior license: **\$65** for first year then **\$39** annual renewal fee

UNALTERED ANIMAL CERTIFICATE

Unaltered animal Certificates are required in addition to the license for any unaltered dog 6 months or older. To obtain a UAC, the dog must have a current license and a letter from the licensed vet on their letterhead stating that the vet has examined the dog within the past year and the owner is following the preventative healthcare program outlined for the animal. The cost is **\$100**. All new certificates require a facility check by an Animal Control Officer. An annual healthcare statement is required to keep the certificate current.

LATE LICENSES

\$15 in addition to the price of the license.

FAILURE TO LICENSE PENALTY

\$30 if impounded. This fee is per dog.

REPLACEMENT LICENSE TAG

\$5 valid through the expiration date of the tag being replaced.

SERVICE/ASSISTANCE DOGS

\$0 fee - Certification is required. Dog must be assessed and pertinent documentation provided. An affidavit must be signed swearing to the validity of the applicant's need for such an assistance dog. Term of the tag is for the life of dog or as long as dog is owned and in service to the person to whom the dog is licensed. Current rabies information must be provided when the dog is revaccinated.
